Youth Activities

Young Shrewsbury's Youth activities returned week commencing 4th November 2024 after the half-term break. All youth clubs held at The Grange, Ditherington, The Hive and The Lodge Monkmoor are back up and running as normal. We are delighted to report that all the numbers attending are up, particularly those at The Lodge with Junior and Senior sessions. The new partnership with the Hive delivering Music activities during these sessions focusing on combating antisocial behaviour has been well received. There are a number of trips and Christmas-based activities planned for the coming weeks leading up to Christmas.

Monkmoor Football and Tennis sessions held at Monkmoor Recreational Ground, supported by Shrewsbury Town Football Club coaches, have been hampered with the poor weather and the closure of the Astro pitch over the last month due to snow and ice.
