It has proven to be another busy and ultimately successful year of Quarry events in 2024. By the time December comes around there will have been 54 individual events held within the park itself, with a further 17 taking place in the Victorian bandstand. As the list demonstrates the type of events being held remains very broad, ranging from the large two-day festivals down to small charity fundraisers.

The event calendar continues to play an important role in the cultural and economic health of the town and although it undoubtedly presents some logistical and environmental challenges, the number of associated issues which have been received this year are extremely small especially in comparison to the visitor numbers which are generated.

The weather in the last 12 months has also created some unprecedented ground condition issues, most notably after the Let's rock concerts, but thankfully the remedial work carried out by our experienced inhouse grounds maintenance team, together with some careful re planning and site adjustments, minimised the impact on subsequent events.

A number of the key calendar events are already provisionally booked for 2025 and we are also regularly receiving enquiries from the organisers of potential new proposals they are developing. It has undoubtedly been a challenging year for the events industry with several high profile casualties at a national level and tickets levels down on previous years, so it pleasing to see our events calendar hold up so well against this backdrop.
