126.1 Proposed speed limit changes in the Oteley Road area, Shrewsbury

The Deputy Town Clerk reported that Shropshire Council proposed to place a 30mph speed limit on the following lengths of roads in Shrewsbury:

- The entirety of B4380 Oteley Road
- That length of Sutton Road from its junction with Oteley Road to a point 31 metres in a northerly direction from that junction.
- Extension of the existing 30mph speed limit along that length of the A458 Wenlock Road from a point 55 metres south-east of its junction with Kingston Drive to its junction with Weeping Cross Roundabout.
- The whole of Weeping Cross Roundabout
- That length of A458 from its junction with Weeping Cross Roundabout to a point 12 metres in a southernly direction from that junction.
- That length of B4380 Thieves Lane from its junction with Weeping Cross Roundabout to a point 10 metres in an easterly direction from that junction.

All papers relating to this proposal were sent out to Councillors prior to this meeting and any comments were required this evening.

Councillor Dartnall fully supported the changes proposed and wished her comments to be made to Shropshire Council. All other members were also in agreement with the proposal.
