THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (VARIOUS ROADS, SHREWSBURY) (AMENDMENT) (PART 2) ORDER 2019

On 19 September 2019 Shropshire Council made an order to make the following changes to parking restrictions in Shrewsbury:

No Waiting At Any Time restrictions will be placed on:

Anchorage Avenue (both sides)	In its entirety
Woodvine Road (Both sides)	From its junction with Arlington Way for a distance of 9 metres in an Easterly direction

Any existing restrictions at the above locations will be revoked.

The Order will come into effect on 21 September 2019.

A copy of the order may be examined during normal office hours (8:45am-5:00pm Monday to Thursday, and 8:45am-4:00pm on Fridays) at Shropshire Council, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury SY2 6ND.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or any provisions in it, on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 19 September 2019, apply for that purpose to the High Court.
