Invitation to tender for the supply of Hostile Vehicle Mitigation devises for use in Shrewsbury Town Centre

Background Information

Shrewsbury Town Council is keeping a solution to the purchase of temporary Hostile Vehicle Mitigation Barriers to support its Terrorrism Management Plan for events in Shrewsbury.

The Town Council works in partnership with Shrewsbury BID on a number of activities including many large-scale public events held with in the town and public parks throughout the calendar year these include Christmas Light Switch-On, Carols in the Square, Battle of Britain Parade and the annual Remembrance parade.

These are the standard annual events but in recent years other large-scale events have included a visit by HM The Queen, Commonwealth Games Commemoration Events and the Proclamation of the King, all of which had high footfall and generated significant risk.

Due to the fact that events are largely held in publicly accessible locations (PALs) and often require road closures to be implemented it has now become apparent that the inclusion of Hostile Vehicle Mitigation is imperative to improve public safety.

The Town Council also hosts a number of other large scale events and discussions are in place regarding their potential use of HVMs.

All of our Outdoor Staff are Chapter 8 trained and are experienced in implementing and managing road closures. It is envisage that their role would be extended to include the installation and management of temporary HVMs.

Shrewsbury Town Council are inviting tenders for the supply of HVM's which will be on an outright purchase to ensure their availability as and when required.

General Scope of Contract

Locations:

Whilst these HVMs are being procured to manage security arrangements in the following streets, we require the flexibility to deploy in other locations as and when required.

In any event we require an overall carriageway width of between 25-30m potentially in multiple locations at any one time.

The existing locations are as follows.

- · High Street (close to Wheatsheaf public House)
- Pride Hill Close to Greggs bakery)
- Princess Street (Rear of Rackhams Building)

Locations map including in this document.

Deployment

The proposed solution should be able to be installed by a maximum of two people who will receive the relevant competency training from the supplier.

Due to the locations and times of day they will be installed it is essential that they can be built on site with the ability to be moved into location as and when required.

Training of Staff

It is expected that the supplier will be provide a competence certificate to deployers following sufficient training on site with the solution for ongoing usage.

Storage and transport

It is expected that the solution can be transported on a trailer of flat bed 3.5 tonne van to site in purpose designed crates to ensure stability and security during transportation. These should be able to be moved using forklifts or a pedestrian pump truck to assist loading and unloading.

They should be able to be stored in the same crates during times of non-deployment. Storage will be offsite at our operational Depot.

Visibility and signage

The solution should be highly visible and should meet current Chapter 8 requirements for use on the highway. Additional lighting should also be available for use in darker areas to protect pedestrians and cyclist during deployment. This can be achieved with flashing chevrons or marker lights.

Certification

As part of your submission please provide all certification for the solution including vehicle weights and speeds. This can be the current British Standards certification or any additional quality checking that has been carried out and must include maximum weights and speeds.

It is expected that all solutions will meet either ISO22343 or the previous requirements of PAS68 or IWA14 Additional attachments such as further vehicle demobilisation techniques should also be highlighted with in your submission.

Please provide a breakdown of the required ongoing maintenance that is required for your solution, also please indicate if you as the supplier would be able to complete ongoing inspections of the solution if needed.
