- **49.1 Ref: Minutes 42.3 Asset of Community Value The Dog & Pheasant** The Town Clerk reported that the Dog & Pheasant has now been registered as an Asset of Community Value.
- 49.2 Consultation of Application 17/04172/DIS Land At Barker Street

 Members were asked to consider the amended plans of the above application
 for an accommodation block for students, management and post-graduates.

Members supported the new plans in principle as they recognise the need for this mixed use accommodation and feel the site is appropriate.

However, they objected to the elevational designs which are unimaginative and not in-keeping with the surrounding buildings. The new construction will sit in a prominent position close to some historic buildings i.e. Rowley's House so Members feel the design is important. They would like to see alternative materials be considered to break up the massing of the block and the introduction of a pitched roof similar to surrounding buildings.

RESOLVED:

That the Town Council objects to this application and that their comments be submitted to Shropshire Council.

49.3 Night Time Economy Plan

The Town Clerk reported that she had attended a meeting with the Head of Planning and Head of Licencing to discuss the progress of the Night Time Economy Plan. She has received a draft copy of the plan, which seemed detailed but confusing and is unspecific to Shrewsbury. The Town Clerk was unable to confirm when the document would be available to Councillors. Further work by Shropshire Council is to be done on the plan and it was reported that communication between the Planning and Licencing departments has improved through this work.

For fear of it being challenged, The Town Clerk is sceptical as to whether Shropshire Council will produce supplementary planning guidance and therefore alternative ideas as guidelines were discussed. This included drawing up zones based on anti-social behaviour figures and involving the Purple Flag working group in pre-application discussions to determine the need for certain licences.

Members requested updates on progress and in the interim seek best practice from other places in the Country where similar projects have been a success. Councillor Roberts will try and find out timescales from Frances Darling.

49.4 Reconsultation Application 17/00867/FUL 37 Porthill Drive

Members were asked to consider a re-submission of the above application expanding the original request from single storey to single and two-storey. Members considered that this was an overdevelopment of the site and created an unacceptable overbearing mass overshadowing the neighbouring property.
