Representatives from Berrys attended the meeting to present their client's planning application. They explained that the property was designed to accommodate a family of seven. The site was situated adjacent to an existing, large scale detached house and was partly made up of a steep gradient which dropped approximately 16 metres down to a tree line. The existing dwelling to the right of the site was set back a considerable distance from the main road (almost 65 metres) and was accessed via a private driveway. This same driveway would be shared access for the proposed dwelling. The proposed area of development within the site was visually well contained being set back almost 80 metres from the A458. There was a plot of

existing woodland to the left of the site which was also in the client's ownership. This woodland would be left untouched in order to retain the wild habitats within. The footprint of the proposed property would be smaller than the property to the right of the site which was Fox Court House which had recently been extended making it a large, 5 bedroom detached property with double garage and annexe above.

Councillor Moseley asked if there had been a pre-application and it was confirmed that there had been.

Councillor Davies enquired about biodiversity on the site and asked if swift bricks would be used. Representatives confirmed they would be open to all suggestions.

The representatives from Berry's were thanked for attending the meeting to present their application to Committee. They then left the meeting.

Whilst the Town Council do not object to the application in principle, Members are concerned with the width of the development and its impact upon the landscape. They commented that it would be a dominant property and expressed concerns about the scale and the mass of the development. Members respectfully request that SC Ecology are consulted regarding biodiversity and potential bat roosting on site. Members request that conditions are established which ensure that the proposed garage remains ancillary to the main property and cannot be sold as a separate residence.
